For his exemplary lifelong work in the field of medical treatment and research

Padma Bhushan Prof.(Dr.) Shiv Kumar Sarin is the Senior Professor, Hepatology and Director of the Institute of Liver and Biliary Sciences (ILBS), New Delhi. He was instrumental in setting it up under the auspices of the Government of Delhi. He is also the Director, WHO Collaborative Centre on Chronic Liver Diseases and Viral Hepatitis at ILBS. He serves as Adjunct Faculty, Molecular Medicine at JNU. He has more than 600 publications to his credit, has edited 13 books on liver diseases and contributed 87 chapters in various medical textbooks.

He has helped develop 19 major guidelines, including six major Asian Pacific Treatment Guidelines, for liver diseases, new treatment protocols for variceal bleeding, liver regeneration, Hepatitis B and acute-on-chronic liver failure. Prof. Sarin has performed various leadership roles as the President of the Indian Society of Gastroenterology, the Indian National Association for the Study of the Liver, and the Asian Pacific Association for the Study of the Liver (APASL) and Chairman, Steering Committee of the APASL. He also served as the Secretary-General, Asian-Pacific Digestive Week Federation (APDWF).

He was awarded the prestigious Henry L. Bockus Medal in 2017 by the World Gastroenterology Organisation. He delivered the Ralph Kohn Memorial Lecture at the Institute of Hepatology, London, and the Prof. Telford Reynolds Memorial Oration at the University of Southern California. He is also recipient of the Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar Award, the World Academy of Medical Sciences prize, the EASL Recognition Award, the Om Prakash Bhasin Award, the Dhanwantri Award, the Ranbaxy Medical Sciences Award and the Best Teacher Award. He is the founding editor of Hepatology International. He developed the Vision 2015 document for medical education in India along with the Board of Governors during his tenure as the Chairman of the Medical Council of India.
